BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS' MEETING

March 4, 2022

Roll call: Present: Bill Prendergast, Chairperson, Aaron Williams and Mary Reilly, Board Members, Kevin Swail, Superintendent, Mark Siegars, District Counsel, Jodi Hollingsworth, Clerk, Lori Dilego, Casey Westwood

Agenda of Meeting is as follows:

1. February 4, 2022 minutes approved 3-0, February 18, 2022 minutes approved 3-0
2. Berkshire Village – Lori Dilego asked questions residents of Berkshire Village had regarding Glassworks Rd and the Right of Way and poor drainage – Dilego to call Billy Decelles to find out what the town is going to do with it – Siegars explained all Berkshire Village residents need to sign a right of entry form allowing Keller to enter their property to install connection – Dilego will notify residents to come to Water District office on March 16, 2022 between 6:00am – 4:00pm to sign form – Keller will give 24/48 hr window to allow entry – Dilego asked the Commissioners about the contents of the Pumphouse and will the District want the contents (pump, lights), and was told they are the Co-ops property and could perhaps sell them
3. Asset Management – District meeting with residents set for March 15 – Tighe & Bond prepared flyer to be sent to all district property owners – Hollingsworth to send to Zip n Sort for mailing
4. Sanitary Survey – To apply for permit to withdraw more water, the District has to provide evidence of how water will be conserved
5. Website update – Asset Management Flyer will be put on website
6. Abatements – 125 South Main Street – abatement approved to TTO rate
7. Berkshire Mall – Siegars explained there is a court order for Mall to fix sprinkler system – Siegars to ask counsel if Water District complaint can be filed through District Court.
8. Water Main – Bangor St - tabled to next meeting
